

FLIGHT STREAM INFOTAINMENT - DESCRIPTION AND OPERATION**1. General**

- A. This section describes the Garmin Flight Stream 510 (FS 510) Infotainment system used on Model 208 and 208B airplanes utilizing G1000 System Software (v.2499.08 and On).

2. Description

- A. The FS 510 is an optional software installation (load) on the 208/208B that is used to control certain aspects of the G1000 system from a Personal Electronic Device (PED) with pilot acceptance of the action. The FS 510 Infotainment system can also be used to monitor the system status of various different functions from a PED. The Infotainment system can be used to update databases to the G1000 system via a wireless connection.
- B. For software loading/troubleshooting of the FS 510 system, refer to Chapter 34, Garmin G1000 Integrated Avionics System - Adjustment/Test and Garmin G1000 Integrated Avionics System - Troubleshooting section of this manual.

3. Operation

- A. The FS 510 operates through the G1000 Integrated Avionics NXi Software (v.4.8) package. For additional information, refer to Chapter 34, Garmin G1000 Integrated Avionics System - Description and Operation.
