LEVELING AND WEIGHING - GENERAL

1. Scope

- A. This chapter provides information necessary to properly level the airplane for any maintenance, overhaul or major repairs which might become necessary.
- B. For information on airplane weighing procedures, refer to the Pilot's Operating Handbook.
